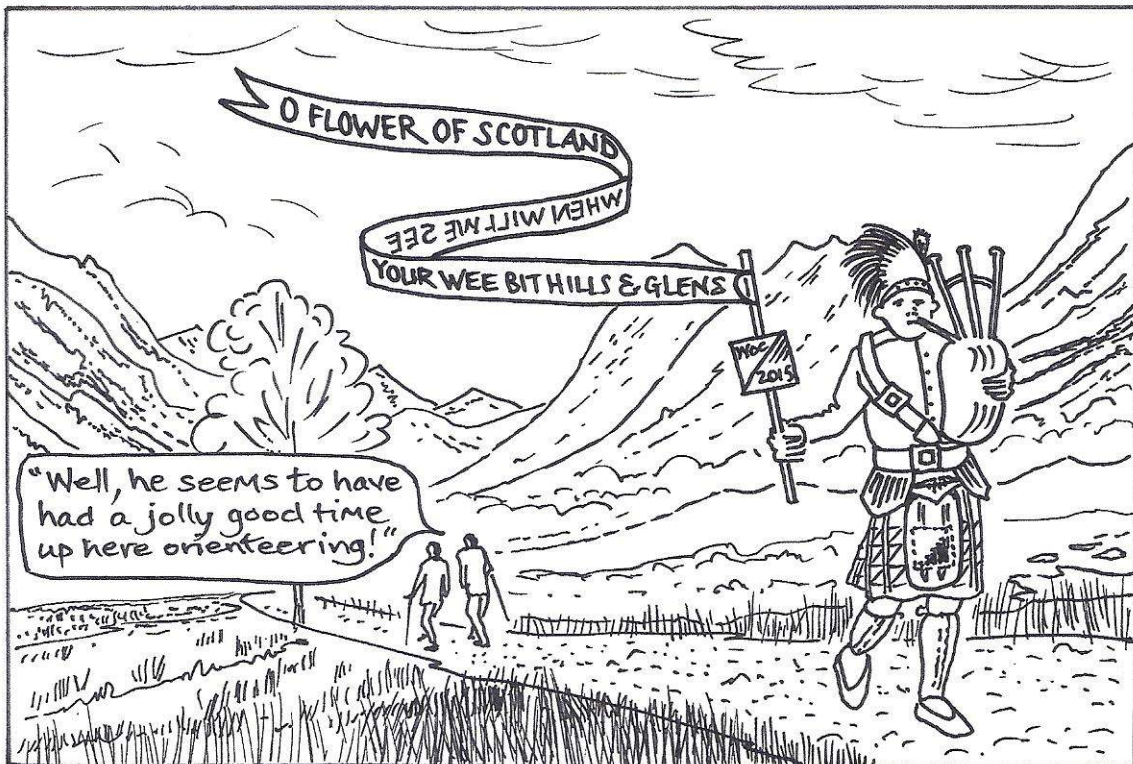

MINUTES OF THE 51st ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE EAST MIDLANDS ORIENTEERING ASSOCIATION HELD ON MONDAY 21st September 2015 at Clifton, Nottingham at 19.30.

- 1. Apologies for absence:** Apologies were received from Dai Bedwell (DVO), Roy Denney (LEI), Judith Holt (DVO), Paul Murgatroyd (LOG), Pauline Olivant (NOC), and Ernie Williams (LEI).
- 2. Minutes of the 50th AGM held on Monday 15th September 2014.** It was agreed that the minutes were a true record as proposed by Ranald Macdonald (DVO) and seconded by Hilary Palmer (NOC).
- 3. Proposed Standing Order Change.** There were no standing order changes to be discussed.
- 4. Chairman's Report**

Firstly I need to explain why this report is being presented by me. At the 2014 AGM I was elected as Vice-Chair and there were no volunteers for the post of Chair, which was left vacant. Subsequently at the first meeting of the Executive Committee I volunteered to act as Chair until the next AGM, Amanda Roberts (LOG) volunteered to take over as Vice-Chair until the next AGM and these appointments were approved by the Committee.

I have been well supported during the year by the three other Principal Officers and I'd like to thank them for their efforts. As Financial Secretary, Mark Webster (NOC) has overseen a turn round in the financial position from a significant loss last year to a small surplus in 2014/15. Our Development Co-ordinator Chris Phillips (LEI) has continued to take forward the regional Development Plan, and Amanda Roberts has gained good experience in the running of the Association.

During the year Dai Bedwell (DVO) has taken over the running of the regional Junior Squad, with assistance from Steve Kimberley (DVO). A well-balanced programme of coaching activities has been carried out, including both sessions within the region and weekends away, and some successful results have been achieved, with a particular highlight being the selection of Hannah Cox (LEI) for the British team at the Junior World Championships (JWOC). Additional sources of income have been tapped (or should I say "baked") and squad finances are back under control.

Due to personal circumstances Paul Beresford stood down as Fixtures Secretary during the year. Thanks are due to Ursula Williamson (LEI) who took over this role at short notice, while also continuing with her previous role as EMOA League secretary.

Thanks are also due to those others with specific roles including John Cooke (Webmaster), Paul Murgatroyd (Urban League secretary), Hilary Palmer (Coaching), David Olivant (Mapping), Roy Denney (National Forest) and John Woodall (President and British Orienteering Director). The Club Representatives have been Bob Haskins (LEI), Amanda Roberts (LOG), Pauline Olivant (NOC) and Mike Gardner (DVO), and Mike has also produced the minutes of our meetings and continued as editor of EMEWS.

All four clubs have continued to provide a regular series of events as part of the EMOA League and urban league, as well as many Level D events and other activities. However after consultation with the clubs we have decided not to go ahead with the suggested EMOA night league.

Major activities during the year included the Midlands Championships held by DVO at Longshaw on 26/10/2014, and the Yvette Baker Trophy final held by NOC at Nottingham University on 5/7/2015. The first EMOA Sprint Championships were held by DVO at Abbotsholme School on 29/11/2014. The EMOA Score Championships should have been held by NOC at Clumber Park on 12/4/2015 but unfortunately this event had to be called off on the morning of the race due to forecast high winds. It has been rescheduled for February 2016.

The Conference for planners and controllers was held at Rushcliffe Country Park on 4/10/2014. Arrangements are well in hand for the next Regional Training and Development Day, which is to be held at Charnwood College on 31/10/2015.

I have no dramatic new plans for next year. We will continue to develop the sport of orienteering within the East Midlands, in line with the specific actions identified in the Development Plan. We will support the interests of

our members and we will seek to increase participation. I think it is particularly important that we should increase participation among the younger age groups and I'd welcome suggestions as to how this might be achieved.

There has been a slight decrease in participation numbers but the event income is up due to raising of levy last year.

Chris Phillips talked about the Development Plan which he had circulated to committee members before the meeting and had available for those present. He will want to look at a longer term strategy during this year as currently it is focused on a year by year basis.

Club reps were asked to consider what they wanted to see form part of the longer term development plan and that this should be added to the next EMOA Committee meeting agenda.

13. **Any Other Business**

Regional Training Day

There are a variety of courses on offer which have been advertised outside the region as well as within EMOA. So far there have been no volunteers for the controllers course which is a concern as we need more volunteers in this area. Ranald Macdonald did state that he is running a controllers course for Grade B/C on 14th November at Eccleshall Woods in Sheffield, so if only one or two controllers do wish to attend they could attend the course Ranald is running.

John Woodall stated that some folk in WMOA thought that numbers were constrained from outside EMOA. The only course where this is the case is the Mappers course (which has limited numbers). John would email secretary of WMOA to ensure they knew this.

Safety Workshop – Hilary Palmer stated that also on 14th November she was running a Safety Workshop (as some folk attending the Development Day were on other courses and so she was running a second course). This was at Rushcliffe Country Park. Having attended the Event Safety Workshop will be mandatory for all officials from 1st January 2017.

The EMOA year end is 30th June 2015, Andrew Lucas issued the following statement.

I have examined the Income and Expenditure Accounts for 2014/5 and the Balance sheet as at 30th June 2015 and confirm they represent a true and fair statement of the finances of EMOA at 30th June 2015."

Andy was thanked for being the independent financial examiner of the accounts.

EMOA made a surplus for 2014/15 of **£8.19**. The budget was for a £1,000 loss, income and expenditure predictions seem fairly close, the coaching development and coach education grant however appear not to have been spent so as an expenditure are lower than budgeted.

Total assets increased as a result of the Junior Squad deposit account and the squad tops, which are now being shown as an EMOA asset.

EMOA Budget for 2015/16

Here is the proposed budget for the A.G.M.

Financial secretary's proposal: No change in the membership fees and the event levies. EMOA no longer keeps electronic equipment to be rented out to clubs, so rental fees are obsolete.

Thus the fees will remain at:

Senior membership fee is £3

Junior membership fee is £1.

Associate membership fee is £10

Club membership fee is £15.

Event levies: 50p per adult and 10p per junior with the first £25 being exempt.

The volunteer development day for this year will offer more including organisers/mappers, safety as well as last year's planners and controllers therefore there is a cost increase.

The junior squad spending shall be restricted to a maximum loss of £1000, and extra spending should come from their deposit account.

There has been some confusion between the coaching community orienteering grant and the coaching development pot. For simplicity and to tie in with the EMOA Development Plan we have gone with a figure of £300 left in the community grant and an annual £200 for coaching development.

Regional Training and Development Day

At Charnwood College, Thorpe Hill, Loughborough LE11 4SQ

As part of the EMOA's commitment to the initial training and development of event officials, coaches and those wishing to refresh their knowledge and experience we will be putting on another series of workshops and courses on Saturday 31st October 2015.

Courses on offer.

Event Safety & Welfare Module (Morning)

This qualification is now mandatory for all events officials.

Event Organiser Level C/B (Afternoon)

Primarily of interest to those Organising Level C and D events for the first time but a re-cap for all organisers.

Event Planner Level C/B.

For all interested in Planning at whatever level, though primarily of interest to those starting at Level C and D. Use will be made of the British Orienteering Appendix to the Rules of Orienteering on Planning.

Controller Level C.

EMEWS

For experienced event officials who wish to take on the role of Controller, primarily at Level C and D. Participants must have planned and organised at Level C within the last 5 years.

Mapping - Basic Course.

This is the first part of a two-day course intended to get novice mappers up to the level where they can carry out initial surveying and cartography, including the use of mapping software.

Physical Conditioning for Club Orienteering Coaches (of any level)

A workshop led by Paul Murgatroyd.

Paul is a member of LOG, an active Level 3 Coach, a senior lecturer in Sport & Exercise Science at the University of Lincoln and is currently working in a consultancy role as the physical conditioning coach to the GB Talent Squad.

During the day there will be a mix of theory and practical examples so that coaches will feel more confident leading physical training in their clubs.

This workshop will be very good personal development for coaches and participants will receive a British Orienteering attendance certificate. For those who may want to progress to Level 3 at a later date, this will count towards your prior learning.
