#### Editorial

As you may have noticed from the cover this is going to be the last EMEWS that is sent out as a paper copy. The rapidly increasing costs of printing and postage (2<sup>nd</sup> class postage went up 5p a few months ago and is to go up a further 2p in April) mean that we would need to keep increasing EMOA membership fees to cover the costs. Instead we hope to try providing EMEWS by email. Already NOC and LOG provide their club newsletters this way, and DVO and LEI are considering this approach.

For the next EMEWS I will create it as normal and then e-mail it to a representative from each club who has the e-mail addresses of the club members and they will email it on. Where members do not have an e-mail address then the clubs will still distribute EMEWS by mail.

We will see how this goes with the next few issues and review this approach. We hope to make sure everyone still gets a copy of EMEWS which they can read. If you don't think you have received your copy then let me know and I'll contact the clubs. A copy of EMEWS will always be available on the EMOA website. It may be that if this is successful we can reduce the EMOA component of membership fees. If you have any views on this then let me know.

## EMOA Committee Meeting Report - December 14th 2009

Vacant Positions - We are still in need of both a Treasurer and Vice-Chairman, especially the Treasurer's role needs to be filled as soon as possible. Please could members think if they could provide a little of their time to assist in one of these roles.

**EMOA Training Day** – The EMOA Training Day on November 7<sup>th</sup> took place at Groby College and was a great success. We had 44 people attending. Thanks go to all the tutors and LEI for organising the venue. Having the different courses all take place at the same venue allowed folk to travel together and discuss their courses at lunch and afterwards. We now should have some more organisers, planners and controllers as well as coaches for the region. It is hoped to repeat the exercise again in around 15-18 months (as it was felt a spring date may be better).

As a result of the day EMOA approved all of the controllers who attended the Grade 2 and Grade 3 controllers courses as controllers as long as appropriate mentoring takes place within the clubs to assist them.

National Coaching Conference 2010 - It was agreed that EMOA would provide a 50% contribution to expenses for any EMOA coaches attending the conference.

Treasurer's Report - The main problem currently is one of cash flow. Due to supporting the VHI for DVO, the EMOA accounts are empty and the Treasurer asked that no-one cash any cheques until funding had been received (since the meeting the funding has been received).

We need to make sure we get the next grant from Sport England for the Satellite Club project during February or we may again be in a situation where we lack funds. The paperwork for getting this grant funding is underway.

There was a question as to whether we were double insuring the Satellite clube SI equipment (through both EMOA and DVO). Derek Gale was investigating this.

Given the situation with the funds due to the VHI, EMOA are going to recommend to British Orienteering Board that in future Clubs and Associations should not need to act as bankers to the event. It has caused us not be able to refund expenses to those doing work on behalf of the association which is embarrassing.

Fixtures - Ian provided a list of Fixtures as he had them. Unfortunately a number of NOC events were missing from the list which had lead to them clashing with other EM League events. Ian's information is only as good as the information he is sent (or is sent to British Orienteering). The committee requested that Ian coordinate all EM league events and try to, where possible, avoid clashes with other EM events.

Fixtures Review - The following comments were made around some of the major events coming up in EMOA:

- 2009 Veteran Home Internationals DVO Longshaw and Eyam (14/15<sup>th</sup> Nov) Feedback on the event was excellent. However, DVO reported that the event was going to make a potential loss of around £700.
- 2010 Midland Champs LEI Belvoir (21<sup>st</sup> Mar) Fees likely to be high as fixed costs for the event (access, car parking, BOF Levies, offset litho printing and toilet hire) are high.
- 2011 Compass Sport Cup and Trophy Final DVO Allocated as 11th November
- 2013 British Schools Orienteering Champs now allocated to EMOA.
- 2013 Yvette Baker Trophy Final EMOA to host

#### Committee Reports

**Coaching** - A new UK Level 2 Coach Qualification has been endorsed by First for Sport, and 2 pilot courses have been run already.

The old UK Steering Group which used to look at Coaching Awards has now been disbanded and the Coaching Committee has taken over responsibility for all of it's terms of reference.

An improved risk assessment form for events is being developed.

Rules Group - Some discussion has taken place about the role and relationship between Rules Group and other committees such as Events Committee.

21 different documents have now been approved - see article from Ernie Williams.

Map Group - A draft proposal for an integrated action plan for mappers is in draft form, with the objective to raise mapping standards.

**BO Board** - The committee's terms of reference were discussed along with preparation for the BO AGM at the JK, including annual subscriptions and levies.

Satellite Club Project - By March it is hoped to have all 6 satellite clubs up and running. There are 3 currently in operation - Buxton, West Notts and Bassetlaw. The remaining 3 - Derby, Chesterfield and Bramcote should be launched early in 2010.

Sport Ident - The insurers have agreed to replace 4 boxes that were lost at LEI events. NOC are looking to get a grant for additional kit from local bodies. It is hoped that eventually each club will have their own kit. The intention would then be that Derek Gale would co-ordinate use of the SI equipment for the larger events, but each club would manage their own equipment. We could then also remove the SI fee that is paid by clubs to EMOA for use of the kit at events.

**EMOA Committee Meetings** - A reminder that any member can come and attend the EMOA committee meetings if they wish to do so (though they cannot vote). Next meetings will again be at Clifton Village Hall starting at 7:30pm on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2010 and then 19<sup>th</sup> April 2010.

Last year we had 40. This year we have 44 (subject to appointments to be made at EMOA meeting on  $14^{th}$  December)

#### Courses:

5 Teaching Orienteering Courses have been completed.

9 New Coaches qualified at UKCC level 1 (LOG (2), LEI (3), DVO (1) and Buxton SC (3)).

Weekly coaching and low key introductory activities have been taking place at all four clubs: in DVO and NOC funded through the Club and coach programme with satellite clubs in Buxton, Mansfield and Retford and in LEI via the Sport Unlimited and BO 'Grow' grants. LOG has also put on many informal activities for their members in the past year.

#### Out and About - Blidworth

This year the East Midlands Championships will be held at Blidworth on  $7^{th}$  February, so don't forget to enter. The woods are named after the village of Blidworth to the North of the area, and the village is known to date back to the  $14^{th}$  century at least, though the modern houses were predominantly built to provide housing the workers at Blidworth Colliery which was in operation from 1926 - 1989.

According to legend, Will Scarlet is buried in the churchyard of the Church of St. Mary of the Purification. An unmarked grave stands near the iron gates of the churchyard, formed from the original apex of the church tower and other assorted stones, and is generally attributed to the outlaw. As outlaws were not generally buried in churchyards, though, it is more likely that, if he existed, Will Scarlet was buried in one of the much older graves to be found on the same hillside within the boundaries of Sherwood Forest.

St Mary's is also one of the few churches in Britain to still perform the ancient 'Cradle Rocking Ceremony' said to represent & celebrate the time that Jesus was presented in the temple.

Other local legends suggest that Blidworth was the birthplace of Maid Marian, although there is little or no evidence to support these claims.



On the outskirts of the village of Blidworth lies a stone known locally as the Druid Stone (Grid Reference: SK578558), a pillar of cemented glacial gravel standing on a base of the Nottingham Castle rock formation (Bunter Pebble Beds). This monumental object is 14ft high, 84ft around the base and has a hollow centre large enough for a man to pass through. This may be the origin of the name Rickett Lane. In ancient times mothers

allegedly brought their children here to pass them through the hole as a supposed protection against rickets. Though known as the Druid Stone there is no evidence to suggest that it has ever been used by Druids, it is a naturally forming outcrop.

Blidworth is also famous for its 'Bowmen' who fought with King Henry V who reigned from 1413 - 1422 & were renowned for their archery skills. It is said that the act of sticking two fingers up at someone, a non too polite gesture, originated with Blidworths' Bowmen. When firing arrows, the archer uses two fingers to draw back the string on the bow. The act of sticking two fingers up was to show the enemy that they still had their two fingers & were still able to draw their bows & fire their arrows.

The new Event Guidelines - whilst being drafted the word 'generic' was used to describe the nature of the documents as they are about a type or format of orienteering without being related to a very specific event - currently available are:

A: Overview of Event Structure	Dec	2009
B: Long Distance Cross Country Events	Dec	2009
C: Middle Distance Events	Dec	2009
D: Sprint Events	Dec	2009
E: Urban Events	Dec	2009
F: Relay Events (Available later in 2010)		
G: Score Events	Dec	2009

For the many orienteers who have regularly attended the 'traditional' Colour Coded Events, then Event Guidelines A and B are the ones to concentrate on, whilst the orienteers who like to compete in the newer orienteering disciplines will find Event Guidelines C to G very useful and informative.

The Event Rules 2010 are already in use as they apply to a range of Level 1 National Events that are being staged between the  $1^{st}$  January 2010 and  $31^{st}$  December 2010:

- A British Elite Orienteering Championships (Long)
- B British Age Class Orienteering Championships (Long)
- C British Elite Orienteering Championships (Middle)
- D British Age Class Orienteering Championships (Middle)
- E British Elite Orienteering Championships (Sprint)
- F British Age Class Orienteering Championships (Sprint)
- G British Relay Orienteering Championships
- H British Night Orienteering Championships
- I <u>Jan Kjellström (Sprint)</u>
- J Jan Kjellström Individual Events
- K <u>Jan Kjellström Relay Events</u>
- L <u>Area Championships</u>
- M Compass Sport Cup and Trophy

- E British Night Orienteering Championships

- I <u>Area Championships</u>
- J Compass Sport Cup and Trophy

On one particular topic - the availability and role of Controllers - there has been considerable discussion and the following information has been made available on the British Orienteering website:

"The Rules of Orienteering, Appendices to the Rules of Orienteering and the Competition Rules 2010 are effective as of 1st January 2010 and will apply for all events in 2010 with one exception, this exception was agreed by Events Committee in July 2009 and covers the Controllers for Regional events. Until the end of 2010, associations are to take responsibility for appointing Controllers to Regional events; where possible Grade 2 Controllers should be used otherwise experienced Grade 3 Controller external to the club staging the event should be used if possible."

Finally, it is appreciated that not all orienteers have internet access and, if this is the case, printed copies of any of the documents can be obtained by contacting the National Office.

We all take part in a great sport and the Rules, Appendices and other documentation are there to ensure that everything is as fair and as well organised, mapped, planned and controlled as is humanly possible - may you have a successful and invigorating 2010 orienteering on parks, urban areas, woods, forests, moorlands and fells!
