Report on East Midlands Meeting - 15th April 2013

East Midlands Champs - This year's East Midlands Champs will be at the LEI Event at Sprint Cottage on 24th November. Provisionally the East Midlands Champs for 2014 will be at the LEI Cademan Wood event in April (though still to be confirmed). Mike Godfree has agreed to co-ordinate the East Midlands trophies.

Treasurer's Report - The treasurer reported that membership figures appear to be in-line with the projected budgeted figures, the levy figures from events is coming in higher than budgeted. There has also been some additional support from local authorities for some coaching events which has reduced the cost of the coaching provided. There will be some additional costs for the Planners / Controllers events at the end of April and the Novice Mappers course later this year.

The major budget item recently has been English Orienteering Association membership.

It was agreed that further discussion was required in how best to manage the funding of the East Midlands Junior Squad (Should they have the funds in a separate account? Should they aim to ensure that all activities never make a profit from the attendees? Viv Macdonald and Pauline Olivant will discuss this with the Junior Squad organisers).

Correspondence - The main item of correspondence has been the new BO Rules for 2014 were available for comment from the region. These will be discussed at the EM Planners and Controllers conference at the end of April. EMOA League - Underway and all on schedule. See scoring and events elsewhere in EMEWS. There had been some proposals about changing the scoring but if possible would only look at changes if we could do some sort of parallel trial to understand the implications.

Urban League - Proposed events in place, 6 this year and should be starting shortly with first event at Chesterfield. Details elsewhere in EMEWS.

Development - Ranald confirmed that the take up of the Planners / Controllers conference was a little disappointing, but the event will still go ahead. There was discussion as to how to get better engagement from folk in these sort of events. Input from members would be welcomed. Would they prefer sessions at events, on evenings, or on weekends?

Mapping Course - Dave Olivant is arranging a Novice Mappers Course (featured elsewhere in EMEWS)

Coaching Sessions - Dai Bedwell is looking to provide additional coaching at a number of the local events across the region (again covered elsewhere in EMEWS).

EMOA Committee - We are still desperate for members to fulfil the key EMOA positions next year. Randal has written an article for EMEWS to encourage members to get involved (and also covering why we need these roles).

EMEWS - It was agreed to delay EMEWS until we had a report from the Planners / Controllers event, but that a mini-EMEWS should go out with some key data in advance (which all should have seen).

Retirement of Pauline Olivant - In thanks for her work as BO Community Development Officer now that she is retiring from BO, Judith Holt presented Pauline Olivant with a bunch of flowers and the committee recorded a formal thanks to Pauline for all her work in support of Community O in the East Midlands.

Shadowing of Juniors - A number of juniors had brought up the point that while out on their courses during EM League Events they often saw other Juniors being shadowed by parents. The comments from the Juniors was that the parents were often heavily assisting their children on the course which often resulted in them getting ranked highly in the East Midlands League. We don't want to discourage parents from shadowing juniors, especially the very young juniors, but would encourage parents to consider how much advice they are providing to their children and if this is likely to result in a high position to show that they are being shadowed in the results (+1 or two names in the results). We may even consider whether we should have shadowed and unshadowed results in the EM League for the shorter courses.

Future Meetings - All meetings to be held at the Pace Room, St Mary's Church, Clifton Village, Nottinghamshire at 7.30 p.m. The dates are 15th July 2013 and then the next meeting will be the AGM which will be on 16th September at the same location. All members are able to attend the meetings, and encouraged to attend the AGM (more details in next EMEWS).

A training course for new mappers is to be held at Riseholme College, Lincoln on Saturday 28th September and Saturday 5th October 2013.

The course will be suitable for anyone who has an interest in helping update existing orienteering maps and those with some mapping experience who wish to develop further.

What's the EMOA ever done for us?

(with apologies to Monty Python's Life of Brian)

It may, or may not, be an exaggeration to say that the East Midlands Orienteering Association (EMOA) has reached a crisis point but it is certainly facing a very uncertain future. In particular, at the moment we are faced with having no principal officers – Chair, Vice-Chair, Financial Secretary and Development Co-ordinator – following the AGM in September unless volunteers come forward.

Why won't people volunteer? Perhaps the roles are seen as too onerous, involve taking on too much responsibility or are just not interesting. I'll return to this later.

All East Midlands clubs have benefitted significantly from a collaborative approach and most continue to do so.

"Such as?" I hear you ask.

Looking at the headings in our current EMOA Development Action Plan illustrates where EMOA support is being focused:

- Development and support for the junior squad
- Co-ordination of the fixtures programme
- Support for a varied range of events at all levels including the EM leagues
- Co-ordination of multi-day events
- Annual volunteer training and development days
- Coaching development
- Conferences and workshops, such as for planners, controllers and mappers
- Support for senior and elite orienteers

In one way or another, ALL East Midlands orienteers have benefitted from a significant number of these activities.

Now, it might be argued that these could be left to the clubs but smaller, and perhaps all, clubs benefit from collaboration and sharing of ideas, experiences and people to run sessions.

"But doesn't it cost a lot of our money?" I also hear you ask.

The annual budget for the above programme of activities is around £3,000 plus about £650 for running costs. The levy per competitor is 40 pence for seniors and 10 pence for juniors; just think what that represents in terms of your total spending on a day out orienteering – entry fees, fuel, food and drink, equipment, etc. It's not necessarily trivial but for most people is not a make or break sum when considering whether to go to an event as against ensuring the development of orienteering skills and providing better quality events through event official development.

How can we ensure that EMOA continues as a useful and viable body?

So, after looking at what the EMOA does for you, what can you do for the EMOA?

(With apologies this time to John F Kennedy – look it up, kids)

We need volunteers to take on the Principal Officer roles for the next year, at least. What do they involve?

Chair – putting together the agenda, chairing the meeting and receiving communication from British Orienteering. In reality, these are all relatively small tasks unless you chose to make them more significant.

Vice Chair – standing in when the Chair can't make a meeting and being part of the Principal Officer group

Development Co-ordinator - putting on at least one volunteer training and development day – primarily for event officials such as planners, controllers and organisers as well as mappers and coaches – and organising a Planner and Controllers Conference. The key to the role is 'co-ordinator' as there are plenty of very experienced people in the East Midlands who are prepared to run the individual sessions.

Financial Secretary – what people used to call a Treasurer. Ask Viv Macdonald, current incumbent of the post, if you want to know more but the task has been made significantly easier now that virtually all transactions are carried out electronically.

The rest of the EMOA Committee is made up of a representative from each club and individuals with responsibilities such as EMEWS, coaching, mapping and fixtures. Volunteers are also welcome for these roles as well.

None of the posts really needs you to have held a similar post in your club. They just require a relatively small amount of time and an enthusiasm for sharing good practice across the region and a commitment to helping improve the orienteering experience of everyone in the East Midlands.

Talking of which, after many years of sterling service, often from a great distance (Pakistan!), Ian Whitehead wishes to stand down as Fixtures Secretary. Ian receives requests for dates from clubs and then co-ordinates these nationally to ensure a balance of events, avoiding clashes if possible. Most, if not all, of this is done electronically. Contact Ian if you are interested in taking on the role.

As a further inducement to volunteering, the committee has been discussing reducing the number of meetings further, dealing with more business electronically and changing the venue if necessary to suit the circumstances of those on the committee at any time. Meetings are currently held at Clifton, south of Nottingham.

If you think you might be interested in becoming involved, speak to one of the current Principal Officers – John Woodall (NOC), Viv and Ranald Macdonald (DVO) - or your club representative – Mike Gardner (DVO), Bob Haskins (LEI), Sean Harrington (LOG) or Pauline Oliviant (NOC).

It would be a shame to see all the hard work of recent years disappearing if the EMOA was no longer to operate as the co-operative and effective body which it currently is.

EMOA Conference for Planners and Controllers

Saturday 27 April 2013

Rushcliffe Country Park

9.30 on Saturday 27 April saw an assembly of planners and controllers from Log, DVO, LEI and NOC ready to discuss all matters pertaining to our sport in order to ensure the competitions we put on are exciting, safe and fair for all.

The day began with Ranald setting the task of defining the main issues that currently face all planners and controllers and it will be of little surprise to readers that the responses from groups centred on safety before, during and after events and how to ensure that competitions were fair.

Hilary Palmer then led the groups through some safety considerations dealing with scenarios that prompted much discussion around the need for communications to be a consideration in and around the on-the-day organisation. The specific scenario about searching for non-returning runners led to deep discussion on the aspect of knowledge of who is out in the area and how they can be contacted.

The groups then looked at a variety of legs on maps submitted by individuals in order to decide on 'good, bad or ugly'. How aspects of leg planning could be improved especially in relation to long distance courses in East Midlands areas where long, effective legs are often difficult to plan was a key talking point.

After a wonderful lunch spread provided by Viv, Sarah and Rachel the groups settled down to an enthralling presentation by John Duckworth who explained his philosophy and implementation of the planning of the British Middle Distance event on Stanton Moor. It was clear to all the immense amount of thought and expertise as well as time that had gone into the work and that all consideration had been given to the aspects of planning that were discussed earlier in the day. The use of the 'Route Gadget' slides exemplified the various challenges that John had planned into courses to explain the variety of route choices available even on very short legs.

Ranald then kept us all up to date with the changes to the British Orienteering rules for 2013 and we looked ahead to the changes to take place in 2014.

Finally we looked outwards with a view to how we could all ensure that our sport demonstrated our wish that we provided best quality events for all in the East Midlands.
