Primarily this is because coaching course budgets not been taken up, and event levies were up (especially due to CompassSport Cup event). 8.	Junior Squad A separate report was provided to the committee from Dai Bedwell. The committee thanked Dai for a good report. This included that the junior squad continues to be active and successful. It has 2 juniors on the Lagganlia tour, one at Deeside and one at Gothenburg. It has also had junior representation at JWOC, on top of recent squad members running at the World Schools in Turkey.  Liaison has taken place between the Junior Squad and Coaching to ensure sharing of resources where possible. There is still no volunteer to act as Junior Squad contact from LEI.  Dai had requested Clubs to identify to him any second year MW12s who are running well on orange/light green and who should be invited to join the squad next season. He will invite them to Squad training in September/October. If there are MW14+ juniors who are running light green or above confidently and who wish to improve their orienteering but somehow have missed out on a squad invitation then he'd like to involve them too.  The Junior Squad looks like it is coming in under budget this year and so the Treasurer plans at this stage to have the same funding available to them next year.  The Junior Squad are also running the Bramcote Event later in the year which will assist their funding.
