

# **EMOA Championships Competition Rules**

### 1 Purpose

- 1. To find the EMOA Champion in age classes from M/W10 to M/W95+.
- 2. To celebrate East Midlands Orienteering for all members.

#### 2 Format

3. A forest long or middle distance orienteering event running a full range of colour coded courses with age classes mapped to courses according to these rules.

## 3 Eligibility

4. All Members of open clubs that are constituent clubs of the East Midlands Orienteering Association.

### 4 Planning

- 5. Courses are to be planned according to the Rules of British Orienteering, noting EWTs of 67 minutes and 30-35 minutes for Long and Middle Distance Black courses respectively.
- 6. Planners must consult the British Orienteering Rules to determine course length ratio. Currently Appendix B.

#### 5 Classes

- 7. Trophies are awarded to all age trophy classes according to the table below.
- 8. The format, courses, classes and eligibility are all determined by this specific local competition Rules (as permitted by Table 14.6 of latest Rules of Foot Orienteering).
- 9. Competitors in championship classes must enter by the trophy age class they are competing in. Other competitors may enter any colour coded course. The B classes accommodate juniors who do not want to or are not ready to run the championship course.
- 10. It is permissible for the Black course to be excluded with M21s running the Brown course.

11. B classes are for runners who are new orienteers or still improving - so they can take part without the pressure of a full championship course.

Eligibility for a B class is self- regulated but typically the junior has started orienteering in the last few years, and they have not achieved two Colour Award run times on the course they plan to be entering. For example, a girl aged 11 or 12 years old in the current year, plans to enter the W12B course (Yellow) because she has not achieved two Yellow colour award times.

Entering the novice B classes M/W18B to M/W12B, will allow the Organiser to identify the East Midland novice winners for each class, allowing their achievements to be announced at the prize giving and noted in the results. There will be no trophies for the novice B classes, just the recognition and applause.
